

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SMYRNA BEER BOARD

The May meeting of the Town of Smyrna Beer Board was held on Monday, May 5, 2025. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Amy Harrison, at 5:01 p.m. at Town Hall, Smyrna, Tennessee. The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairperson Amy Harrison.

Chairperson Amy Harrison, Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratt and Board Members Jacqueline Redmond and Jennifer Brittain were present for the meeting. Board Member Benjamin Franklin was not present for the meeting. Town Attorney Jeff Peach and Town Clerk Amber Hobbs were also in attendance.

There were no citizen comments to consider.

The Board next considered a motion by Board Member Jennifer Brittain to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2025 regular meeting of the Beer Board. The motion was duly seconded by Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratt and subsequently approved 4-0.

There was one item under old business for the Board's consideration; an application for an on-premise permit for Taco Station Corporation, 1344 S Lowry Street, Smyrna. This item was deferred from the March 3, 2025 and the April 7, 2025 meeting. Owner Ana Rocio Ledezma was present at the March meeting, but was not present to speak at April 7, 2025 meeting concerning the application. Prior to the May 5, 2025, meeting Town Clerk, Amber Hobbs, received a telephone call from the applicant requesting to withdraw her application for an on-premise permit; stating that she had decided not to sell beer.

The Board next considered under new business an application for an on-premise permit for Yummy Poki, LLC, 901 Rock Springs Road, Suite 110, Smyrna. Owner, Phoutsady Miko Norasing and Manager, Jenny Morris, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Vice-Chairperson Jason Surratt made a motion to approve the on-premise permit application for this location. The motion was duly seconded by Board Member Jennifer Brittain. Following further discussion, the motion was approved 4-0. A copy of said application is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "1".


The Board next considered an application by Carpe Artista, Inc. for a special event permit for the 2025 Simply Smyrna Celebration. Carpe Artista, Inc. owner, Ron Alley, spoke concerning the application. Following discussion, Vice-Chairperson, Jason Surratt, made a motion to approve the special event permit application for the 101 Front Street beer garden during the event on June 14, 2025. The motion was duly seconded by Board Member Jennifer Brittain. Following further discussion, the motion was approved 4-0. A copy of said application is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "2".

There were no further new business items for the Board to consider.


Chairperson Amy Harrison stated that the next meeting will be held June 2, 2025.
