CLEAN UP

Upon leaving the building, the Renter is responsible to see that the following have been completed:

- Clean all tables and chairs
 - Return tables to original set-up
 - Place all trash in cans provided, dumpster is behind building
 - Sweep floors, Mop up spills
 - Remove all personal items
 - Turn interior lights off and exterior lights on before leaving
 - Close and lock all doors.
- The building should be returned to the condition in which it was prior to use, the deposit will not be refunded and future use may be denied.
- Possibility of another group to use the facility after you leave.

PROHIBITED: NAILS, STAPLES, COMMAND STRIPS, TAPE ON WALLS, CEILING, WINDOWS, OR DOORS

SMOKING OR TOBACCO PRODUCTS

Clean facility and secure building before leaving.

Town not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Town not responsible for any items brought into the building.

Return building key to Parks Office the next business day. Failure to return key or clean facility will result in forfeiture of the deposit.

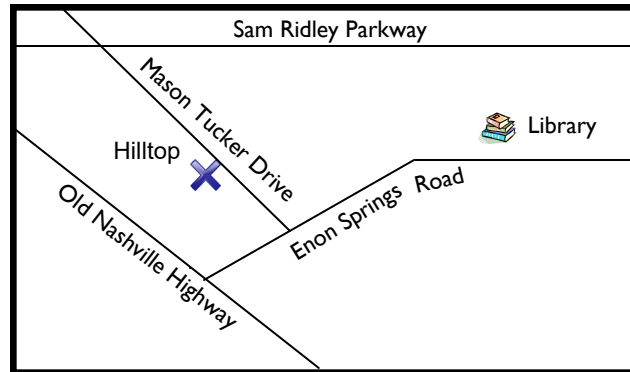

Any Renter found to be in violation of any rules or regulations for use will forfeit the deposit and right to reserve the facility in the future.

Take I24 from Nashville and exit 66B Sam Ridley Parkway exit, from Murfreesboro take exit 66 Sam Ridley Parkway and turn right onto Sam Ridley Parkway.

Go 1.5 miles to the CVS turn right onto Old Nashville Highway, go 1.2 miles and turn left onto Enon Springs Road, go .3 miles and turn left onto Mason Tucker. Park is on your left.

Rosenwald Community Center History

In 1913, Julius Rosenwald, a clothes manufacturer and co-owner of Sears Roebuck and Company, teamed with Booker T. Washington to improve education for African Americans. The results were available grants for school construction in the south and southwest. The Smyrna Rosenwald School was one of 5,000 + Rosenwald schools built in the early 1900's. The Rosenwald school was built in Smyrna in 1927. There were five teachers at Smyrna Rosenwald, which was the largest school for African-Americans in Rutherford County. The school remained open until 1960 when it was relocated to Old Nashville Highway.

In 2000, the Town of Smyrna received a 7 acre land donation from the heirs of D.E. Coleman. An additional 9.3 acres of land was later purchased from the heirs of Leon Alford to build Hilltop Park. Hilltop Park opened in 2003.

A committee of former Rosenwald School students and community members then formed the Hilltop-Rosenwald Historical Committee. The committee along with the Town of Smyrna began planning the construction of Rosenwald Community Building, a replica of the Smyrna Rosenwald School. On July 23, 2005 the community center opened and is now available to the community for rent and stands as a historical dedication to the Rosenwald schools.

RENTAL FEES:

All Day Rental 9am - 9pm \$200

Fee Change for 2026:

- Smyrna Residents: \$200.00
- Non-Residents: \$250.00

All renters are required to stay within their time allotment.

Renters are not allowed to go in early or stay later.

Renter should submit completed application, obtain approval of application, and pay rental fee within 14 days of initial date of booking your reservation. If rental fee is not paid within the 14-day period, your reservation date will be released and available for rental by another party.

Deposits of \$200 are required for all rentals.
